SOUTHWEST JUNIOR ACADEMY (SWAJA) – 2023-2024 REGISTRATION



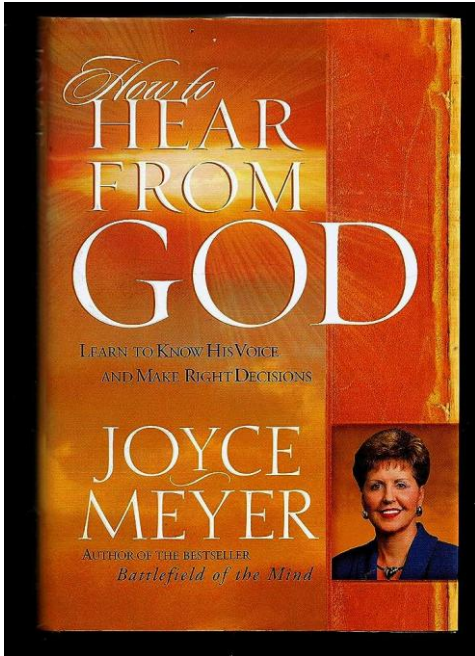
